Information about the election.

The inhabitants of Ullensaker have a diversity of cultures and ethnicities. In fact, 35% of us have a background other than Norwegian.

Even so, the participation in elections is very low. Only 57% used their right to vote in the last municipal election.

So if you turn 18 by the end of 2023 and have been a registered resident in Norway since before 11 September 2020, you have the right to vote.

It is important for us that our democracy reflects the citizens who actually live here. And our citizens come from 28 different nations.

Among other things, we at MDG have made sure to establish a council for multicultural people in order to strengthen the ties between politics and our diverse society.

MDG has three basic principles of solidarity for all our policies: solidarity with other people, future generations, and animals and nature.

We will:

Promote diversity and inclusion for an inclusive local community.

Have good schools and living conditions for all our children.

Take care of volunteering, promote measures that prevent loneliness and provide safe neighborhoods.

We want urban development to be characterized by quality, good meeting places and to build permanently safe solutions for the diversity of the future.

Ensure that Ullensaker has a healthy economy and address social inequality.
